

Child Questionnaire 2022-23



ANALYSIS

The results of our recent children's questionnaire were really positive. The results have been analysed so that we can improve our provision further at St. Peter's.

Who helps you in class? Adult-17 Partner/Buddy-10 Both-13 I work independently-8.

- Results show an increase on children using help from a buddy or working independently. It is good to see that children are actively trying to work independently and that our mixed ability partners in classrooms are encouraging the children to work together before relying on an adult.

Do you feel you have enough help? Yes- 26 No-7. Reasons: Maths help, sometimes, writing, like to sit with someone, read my work to me.

- Results show that the majority of children feel they have enough support in class with a slight increase on the previous years percentage. It is positive to see that there are fewer maths support related comments on this years questionnaire, indicating that children feel better supported in their maths work.

What do you do if you are stuck? Ask a partner/buddy- 12 Put my hand up- 15 Ask an adult- 19 Think it through myself- 13 Ask a partner and an adult- 6

- Again, it is good to see that the mixed ability partners in class are having a positive impact on encouraging children to work together. It is also good to see that children are confident in trying to work independently and think their work through as one only child answered this option on the previous questionnaire.

What or who helps if you are worried, frightened or angry? Adult-24 Partner/Buddy-12 Talking-10 Nothing-2 Other- 0

 All children know that there are a variety of ways that they can get help if they feel frightened, worried or angry. It is good to see that the children are confident in talking to others to share their feelings.

When asked what else would help you in class with your learning children said:

My friends Number lines and words help me Looking at number lines
Calculator
Listening to a teacher
More phonics
Writing frames
Phonics frames
Listening more
Handwriting practice
Help with grammar.

- Results are shared with all staff in school so that they can look at the resources that the children have mentioned, and where possible ensure they are available in all classes.

When asked if there was anything else that they would like to say about the help and support received at St Peter's the children said:

I like learning at St Peter's

Coming to school makes me happy

I like coming to school

I like it, it [school] helps me to learn

Thank you for supporting me and helping me because it makes things easier

Fantastic because they help me

It's okay help

It's nice help

I get enough support

I get lots of help

I now have good handwriting

I think I get lots of help in my work

I think it's great and I have enough help

I enjoy the work with Miss Monika but not boosters

I like it when I can work independently. If my partner can't help I ask an adult

My partner and adult helps so I get much better

I like it now I can do my work.
